

January 12, 2015

The City Council met in a public hearing at 6:55 P.M. The public hearing was for an Ordinance to vacate identified Right-of-Ways for portions of: Magnolia Street, Hillcrest Avenue, and their associated Alley-Ways and return the underlying property to the adjoining property owners currently identified as First Presbyterian Church and Lenoir City Cemetery. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Councilmen were present: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler. James W. Wilburn III., James K. Scott, and Amber Scott-Kelso were also present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Hines to approve the minutes of the December 8, 2014 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to adopt an Ordinance to vacate identified Right-of-Ways for portions of: Magnolia Street, Hillcrest Avenue, and their associated Alley-Ways and return the underlying property to the adjoining property owners currently identified a First Presbyterian Church and Lenoir City Cemetery. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2015-01-12-2075.**

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Shields to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation regarding adoption of an Ordinance annexing property located off Highway 321 North, containing approximately 8.64 acres, referenced by Loudon County Tax Map 5, Parcel 14.01 and portion of Parcel 17.00, incorporating same within the corporate boundaries of Lenoir City, Tennessee, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 13-7-201 through 13-7-205 and 6-51-102. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Shields to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation regarding adoption of an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for Annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to 6-51-102 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 8.64 acres located off Highway 321, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Map 5, Parcel 14.01, and portion of Parcel 17.00 also being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Simpson seconded by Wampler to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt a Resolution to accept the completed street within the Villas of Harrison Glen Residential Development. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **Resolution 2015-01-12-2076.**

A motion was made by Henline seconded by Shields to adopt an Ordinance to contract certain right-of-way out of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated 13-7-201 through 13-7-205 and 6-51-201, with said territory being approximately 3.2 total miles of Interstate 75. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Hines to adopt an Ordinance regulating vicious or potentially dangerous animals within the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Wampler seconded by Johnson to approve the 2013-2014 Budget Amendments for the Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, and Sanitation Fund.

The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Johnson seconded by Henline to approve the expenditure of \$20,038.00 for Laptop Computers for use in the Police Department. These Laptop Computers are partially obtained through a 75/25 State Grant and purchased through the State Contract. The State Grant will be \$15,000.00 and the Lenoir City Drug Fund will pay \$5,038.00. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Shields to approve all bills and accounts be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Johnson to adjourn the January 12, 2015 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.
