

August 11, 2014

The City Council met in a public hearing at 6:50 P.M. The public hearing was for an Ordinance to propose an amendment to the Charter of the City of Lenoir City by deleting the last sentence of the paragraph which reads: "The City Recorder/Treasurer shall be elected for a four (4) year term at the next regular election following the expiration date of the incumbent's term and replaced with After November 2016, the position of City Recorder/Treasurer will no longer be elected, but rather appointed in accordance with Article VIII, Section 1. And further amended in Article III, Section 4, Section 2, by deleting item (A) and (B), substituting the following, and renumbering the subsequent item: A. City Council members and School Board Members are elected for a four (4) year term. And further amended in Article VIII, Section 1, by inserting the following before the first sentence of the section: The City Council shall appoint a Recorder/Treasurer to serve at its pleasure. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Councilmen were present: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler. James W. Wilburn III., James K. Scott, and Maggie Hunt were also present.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the July 28, 2014 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Simpson to adopt an Ordinance to propose an amendment to the Charter of the City of Lenoir City. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2014-08-11-2061

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Shields to adopt a Resolution requesting the Loudon County Election Commission to include a question on the ballot of the November 4, 2014 Election. (Shall Lenoir City amend its charter to allow the City Council to appoint a qualified City Recorder/Treasurer rather than having an elected City Recorder/Treasurer)? The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Resolution- 2014-08-11-2061

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to adopt an Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §13-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone certain properties located along Creekwood Park Boulevard from R-4 Residential District to C-3 Highway Commercial District. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Henline to approve the revised lease agreement with Norfolk Southern for use of parking lot behind Roane State Community College. The amount to be paid will be \$342.50 starting June 2015. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Simpson to approve all bills and accounts be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Hines to adjourn the August 11, 2014 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler voting **AYE**. Johnson voting **NO**.
