The City Council met in a Public Hearing at 6:50 P.M. The Public hearing was for an Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to 13-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone certain properties located along Creekwood Park Boulevard from R-4 Residential District to C-3 Highway Commercial District. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 7:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Councilmen were present: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson, and Wampler. James W. Wilburn, James K. Scott and Maggie Hunt were also present. Councilman Johnson was absent.

A motion was made by Hines and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the August 25, 2014 City Council meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried.**

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

This request will not exceed \$5,000.00. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried.**

Motion was made by Henline seconded by Hines to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation regarding permission to do Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for design services for the War Memorial Building Restoration Project. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried.**

Motion was made by Hines seconded by Wampler to adopt an Ordinance to establish/erect a "Hidden Driveway" Sign between Fifth (5) Avenue and Sixth (6) Avenue at North G Street. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried. First Reading.**

Motion was made by Henline seconded by Hines to approve the street closure on Broadway from Kingston Street to C Street for the Downtown Street Festival on September 20, 2014 from 6:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried.**

Motion was made by Hines seconded by Shields to approve the street closure on Broadway from B Street to Grand Street for the Lenoir City Homecoming Parade on September 25, 2014 from 6:00 P.M. to 6:20 P.M. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent. **Motion Carried.**

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Henline to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Councilman Johnson absent.
