1. Introduction

- 2. <u>Work Progress Since Prior Progress Meeting</u> Completed clearing, continued stream relocation excavation, started 2-inch waterline installation, continued material delivery and installed inline 12-inch water valve on Harrison Road.
- 3. Forecast of Upcoming Work to be Performed Complete 2-inch waterline, test and disinfect, begin/schedule 8-inch sewer in intersection, begin installation of 30-inch storm sewer along Kingston Street, Begin work along Harrison Road on May 19th when road is closed.
 Schedule Update Contractor indicated only minor changes were required and an updated/ revised schedule would be provided post meeting.
- 4. <u>Field Observations, Problems, Conflicts</u> None Noted.

OLD ITEMS

- A. Harrison Road Closure Road closure was approved at the May 8th City Council meeting for May 19th through August 2nd. Contractor was reminded this will be the extent of the closure. Once school resume the road will need to be reopened. Every effort should be made to get as much work done as possible while the road is closed.
- B. Temporary Waterline Decision has been made to connect hydrants utilizing a 2-inch temporary hose for the purpose of providing domestic water supply to the school during the summer shut down. Teachers will occupy the building through the 19th and will return on July 31st. Fire protection will be required while the building is occupied.
- C. Progress Payment Payment No. 1 is progressing. It is due on or before the 20th. The Pay App #2 for May will be required to be submitted to Amber Scott/Maggie Hunt before the 15th of June due to end of fiscal year for LC.

NEW ITEMS

A. Contractor was reminded traffic control plans for the temporary road closure/detour and any temporary lane closures will be required.

5. Request for Information (RFI)

A. Contractor noted rock excavation is being required for 2-inch waterline. Question was raised regarding payment of rock quantities. Discussions noted that roadway



- quantities and utility quantities are totally separate. All utility excavation is unclassified and rock is incidental. Contractor will provide a formal RFI for review.
- B. Utility contractor noted sanitary sewer installation in the intersection would require coordination regarding sewer flows during the replacement. Contractor also questioned if a filter bag would be required for the stream "pump around". If no silt from our site is evident in the stream a filter bag will not be required.

- A. Outstanding Manhole 18 depth issue. Storm sewer at MH 38/39 on Town Creek Parkway and Intersection with Kingston Street.
- B. Upcoming/Critical Submittals- Contractor reminded no Concrete submittals have been provided.
