Special-Called City Council Meeting

The Lenoir City Council will hold a Special-Called Meeting at City Hall on Monday, June 5, 2017 at 1:30 P.M, with Public Hearings beginning at 1:00 P.M. The purpose of the meeting will be to consider the following:

- Ordinance for the Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Community Development Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Capital Projects Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Lenoir City DEA Fund, and Lenoir City State Drug Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018.
- Ordinance to provide Revenue for the Municipality of Lenoir City, County of Loudon, Tennessee for the Property Tax Year 2017.
- Ordinance for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2017 and ending June 30, 2018: General Purpose Fund, Sales Tax Fund, Federal Projects Fund, and Food Service Fund.
- Ordinance authorizing the acceptance of a Stormwater Utility Fee as mandated by Congress.
- Ordinance to amend Section 8-101 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code defining alcoholic beverages (to reflect current State law).
- Ordinance to amend Section 8-206 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code defining beer (to reflect current state law).
- Ordinance authorizing the City of Lenoir City to impose and collect an inspection fee concerning alcoholic beverages.
- Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §13-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone property located at 705 Bon Street from C-3 Highway Commercial District to R-3 High Density Residential District.
- Ordinance establishing a Four-Way Stop at the intersection of G Street and 7th Avenue in Lenoir City, Tennessee.

Other items that will be considered in the meeting are as follows:

- Resolution designating additional contribution to the Loudon County Economic Development Agency for a non-recurring (one-time) expenditure for Fiscal Year 2017-2018.

- Resolution for tentative award from City of Lenoir City to Haren Construction Company, Inc. of Etowah, Tennessee, at the total bid price of \$2,417,000.00 for Main Pump Station #1 Replacement Project.
- Consideration of street closure for a block of Bell Avenue for the purpose of Vacation Bible School.
- Consideration of Purchasing Committee's recommendation regarding expenditure for sod at the Central Park.
- Consideration of Purchasing Committee's recommendation regarding installing posts at Central Park fence.
- Consideration of Purchasing Committee's recommendation regarding going to bid for vehicle for Street Department.
