

January 13, 2025

The Lenoir City Council met in a Public Hearing at 5:50 P.M. on Monday, January 13, 2025. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance amending Title 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee to adopt electronic citation regulations and fees. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Maggie Hunt, Shawn Bunch, Jim Wilburn, LaVonne Barbour, and Walter Johnson were also present. Amber Scot Kelso was absent.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler to approve the minutes of the December 9, 2024 meeting. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens updated the council that we will be adding a line to future City Council Agendas to accept agenda as written. City Council agreed to accept tonight's agenda as written with the exception of Item Number #5. The correct amount should be \$60,444.60.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding and item/items on the agenda. Mr. George Bove expressed his sincere appreciation for the exceptional job the Lenoir City Street Department did with clearing the streets during the recent snow.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Kennedy to adopt Ordinance to amend Title 3 of the Municipal Code of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee to adopt electronic citation regulations. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE. Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2025-01-13-2421-A-O.**

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation and purchase ½ ton truck for use in the Stormwater Department from Lenoir City Chrysler for \$45,000.00. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Brandon to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation for the CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) Streambank Stabilization Phase II for \$377,300.00 from Southern Constructors. The remainder after the grant would be paid out of the Stormwater Budget. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation declaring 2022 Chevrolet Tahoe as surplus property in the Police Department. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Simpson to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation to purchase 2025 Chevrolet Tahoe off State Contract with Wilson County Motors for \$60,444.60 taken out of DEA Funds. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by McNabb to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation and approve expenditure for tree stump grinding and debris removal at City Park from Thomas Contracting totaling \$9,700.00. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Kennedy to adopt Resolution to authorize and appropriate funds for one or more actuarial studies to determine the cost(s) associated with establishing certain benefit improvement(s) authorized under Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8, Chapters 34-37 for members of the Tennessee Consolidated Retirement System. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson to approve permanent full-time employment for Mr. Robert K. Hamilton, six (6) months probationary period satisfactorily completed (effective January 13, 2025). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Brandon to approve permanent full-time employment for Ms. Isabella Smiddy, six (6) months probationary period satisfactorily completed (effective January 13, 2025). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve permanent full-time employment for Ms. Leah Howard, six (6) months probationary period satisfactorily completed (effective January 22, 2025). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Brandon to renew term for Ms. Carol Beach as City Council Representative on the Civil Service Board (expiring January 31, 2028). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by McNabb to declare certain items as surplus property in the Police Department (list attached). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Shields to declare certain items as surplus property in the Parks and Recreation Department (list attached). The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens concerning item/items not on the agenda.
