The Lenoir City Council held a Public Hearing at 5:45 P.M. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance to amend Title 11, Chapter 2, Section 11-202(1)(h) of the Lenoir City Municipal Code for allowed schedule of Building Operations. Additionally, the City Council held a Public Hearing at 5:50 P.M. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 3.0 acres located off Williams Ferry Road, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Map 10H, Group A, Control Map 10H, Parcel 12.00 and 13.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. Following the Public hearing City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Brandon, Wampler, Shields, and Simpson. Henline and Hines were **ABSENT**. Amber Scott, Jim Wilburn, Maggie Hunt, LaVonne Barbour, and Gregg Harrison were also present.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the February 22, 2021 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Brandon, Wampler, Shields, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Henline and Hines **ABSENT**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

Mayor Aikens requested an amendment to the minutes from the February 22, 2021 meeting to add the language "no action was taken by City Council." The full language on the minutes will read as follows: "Lenoir City Municipal Court Judge Robin McNabb requested back pay from the City of Lenoir City for Health Insurance she denied when she was elected in August of 2016. No action was taken by City Council." A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the amendment. The following vote was recorded: Brandon, Wampler, Shields, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Henline and Hines **ABSENT**.

Ms. Vicki Cowell with the Prevention Alliance of Loudon County presented a brief presentation to promote "Fun Raising" efforts for the Carboard Boat Race. This is in the planning stages and will be to bring awareness to Prevention Alliance.

The following vote was recorded: Brandon, Wampler, Shields, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Henline and Hines **ABSENT**.

Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2021-03-08-2285-B

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt Resolution annexing property located off Williams Ferry Road, containing approximately 3.0 acres, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Map 10H, Group A, Control Map 10H, Parcel 12.00 and 13.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary.


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
