The Lenoir City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Amber Scott, Maggie Hunt, and Gregg Harrison were also present.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the April 12, 2021 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens requested to add an item to the agenda to approve Zack Cusick's promotion to Park and Recreation Director and approve the Employment Agreement between Zack Cusick and the City of Lenoir City. A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler to add the item to the agenda as Item #3. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens requested to add an item to the agenda for consideration to make back-alley behind Central Park from Hill Street to Grand Street a one-way street. A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to add the item to the agenda as Item #4. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens requested to add an item to the agenda for consideration to approve Amendment Number #3 to contract between the City of Lenoir City and the Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) for Phase I of the "Lenoir City Intelligent Transportation System: Signal System." A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to add the item to the agenda as Item #5. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

Rachel Harrell, Director of the Loudon County Visitor Bureau, addressed the Mayor and City Council of all the events happening in Lenoir City and Loudon County and awarded a plaque to Lenoir City for the "Bass Nation Tournament" that was held in Lenoir City on April 11, 2021.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Henline to award the Residential Waste Collection to Brewster's Services Group, LLC with the bid of \$6.50 per stop. The other bids were: No Name on Outside of Envelope and required information not on the outside of the envelope - Rejected, and Waste Authority, also without required information on the Outside of Envelope - Rejected). T.C.A. §62-6-102 states that any prime contractors with bids of \$25,000.00 or more for a service must provide contractor license information on the outside of the envelope with the name as licensed, license number, Expiration date and the Classification applying to the bid. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Henline to award the only received bid to Jinks Concrete Contractors for the Central Park Phase II Sidewalks at \$46,666.29. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Brandon to approve Zack Cusick's promotion to Parks and Recreation Director and approve the Employment Agreement between Zack Cusick

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.


