

May 24, 2021

The City Council of Lenoir City met in its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, May 24, 2021 at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon. Councilman Henline and Councilman Simpson were absent. Amber Scott, Gregory Harrison, and Maggie Hunt were also present. Jim Wilburn was absent.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve the minutes of the May 10, 2021 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline, and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

Mayor Aikens reminded everyone the meetings for June 14, 2021, and June 28, 2021 have been cancelled. Mayor Aikens announced a Special Called City Council Meeting will be held on Monday, June 21, 2021 at 10:00 A.M. The second and final reading of the 2021-2022 budget will be on the agenda.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to adopt Ordinance for the Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Community Development Fund, Home Program Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, Lenoir City DEA Fund and Lenoir City State Drug fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance to provide Revenue for the Municipality of Lenoir City, County of Loudon, Tennessee for Property Tax Year 2021. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance to amend the refuse collection fees of the City of Lenoir City per Title 17, Chapter 1, Section 17-109 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code, entitled "Refuse Collection Fees." The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance for the General Purpose Fund for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline, and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance for the Sales Tax Fund for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline, and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance for the Federal Projects Fund for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance for the Food Service Fund for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve closure of Depot Street from Bank Street to corner of South A Street (and parking lot behind Lenoir City Museum) for event on Saturday, July 31, 2021 from 3:00 P.M. – 5:00 P.M. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 contract with Brown Jake & McDaniel, PC to audit accounts for the City of Lenoir City. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Hines to approve the July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021 contract with Brown Jake & McDaniel, PC to audit the Retirement Income Plan for the Employees of the City of Lenoir City. The following vote was recorded: Hines, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Henline and Simpson were **ABSENT**.


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
