

June 10, 2024

The Lenoir City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, June 10, 2024 at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon. Simpson was Absent. Walter Johnson, Amber Scott Kelso, Maggie Hunt, and LaVonne Barbour were also present.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

Mayor Aikens had City Attorney Walter Johnson give an update on the lawsuit between Loudon County Commissioner Van Shaver and the City of Lenoir City.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Kennedy to adopt Ordinance for the Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, HOME Program Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Funds, Ninth Judicial District Drug Task Force Fund, Lenoir City DEA Fund, and Lenoir City State Drug Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance to provide Revenue for the Municipality of Lenoir City, County of Loudon, Tennessee for Property Tax Year 2024. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and Seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2025 for the General Purpose Fund. A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Shields to approve 2023-2024 Budget Amendments for Lenoir City Schools Sales Tax Fund. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Brandon to approve the Lenoir City Board of Education's recommendation to enter into a lease agreement for a period of five (5) years with Canon Solutions of America for a copier. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt Ordinance establishing a moratorium prohibiting the building of apartments/multi-family housing within the Corporate Limits of Lenoir City for a period of one (1) year. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt Ordinance to amend Chapter 6- Section 11-604 of the Lenoir City Municipal Code, more commonly know as the Lenoir City Zoning Ordinance, in regard to the regulation of Public Election Signs. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Henline to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt Ordinance to vacate identified right-of-way for portion of unimproved H Street and return the underlying property to the adjoining property owner currently identified as Lauren Gregory. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve the Planning Commission's recommendation to adopt Ordinance to vacate identified right-of-way for portions of unimproved road of Harrison Avenue and return the underlying property to the adjoining property owner currently identified as JBT Holdings. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Kennedy to approve Matthew Coleman to serve on Group B for the Industrial Development Board of Lenoir City following the resignation of Mr. Glenn Hill. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Shields to declare certain items as surplus property in the Police Department (list attached). The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

A motion was made Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve permanent full-time employment for Mr. Michale Brandon Cole, six (6) months probationary period satisfactorily completed. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Kennedy to hire Mr. Cody Fine to fill vacancy in the Police Department. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.




Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
