The Lenoir City Council met in a Public Hearing at 5:50 PM regarding an Ordinance for providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 1.82 acres located at Highway 70 and Highway 321, furthermore identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 009L, Group A, Parcel 025.02 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The Lenoir City Council met in another Public Hearing at 5:55 PM regarding an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 3.23 combined acres located at 103 Robinson Drive, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Control Map 015M, Group A, Parcels 004.00 and 004.01 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The Lenoir City Council met its regularly scheduled City Council Meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. G. Chance Harrison, Shawn Bunch, LaVonne Barbour, and Jim Wilburn were also present.

During the second public hearing, Pastor Eddie Click spoke on concerns with the annexation request for property located at 103 Robinson Drive.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the June 23, 2025 meeting. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler to accept the agenda as written. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve hiring Mr. Donald Carroll to fill the position of SRO Officer within the Police Department. This will be a lateral transfer. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Kennedy to adopt Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 1.82 acres located at Highway 70 and Highway 321, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Map 009L, Group A, Parcel 025.02, being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, Simpson voting **AYE**. McNabb voting **NO**.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Kennedy to adopt Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 3.23 combined acres located at 103 Robinson Drive, furthermore identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 015M, Group A, Parcels 004.00 and 004.01 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

**Second and Final Reading. Ordinance 2025-07-14-2443-O-A.**

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson to adopt Resolution annexing property located at 103 Robinson Drive, containing approximately 3.23 acres, furthermore identified as Loudon County Tax Map 015M, Group A, Parcels 004.00 and 004.01 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.


**Resolution 2025-07-14-2443-R.**


Mayor Aikens asked for other comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
