A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Kennedy to fill vacancy in the Fire Department and hire Mr. James Kincaid. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Kennedy and seconded by Simpson to approve quote from Volunteer Striping for \$9,687.00 for striping project along the area of McGhee Boulevard. The following vote was recorded: McNabb, Wampler, Kennedy, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.



Ms. Kelso shared that she distributed the required Report on Debt Obligation for the LCUB Electric Bond, as required by the Tennessee Comptroller's Office.


